Monika Dobrovičová completed her master's degree in teaching general education subjects – English language and art education – at the Faculty of Humanities and Natural Sciences at the University of Prešov in 1999. The following year, she passed the rigorous examination and was awarded the degree PaedDr.

Since then, she has worked at various types of schools, ranging from elementary and secondary schools to universities. She also worked at the private language school IH Caledonian School, where she gained experience in teaching company courses and business English. She later applied this experience at the Faculty of Management at Comenius University, where she worked as an English language lecturer/instructor in the Department of Economics and Finance, running seminars on professional English focused on management and related topics.

In 2015, she successfully completed her doctoral studies and was awarded the title PhD. From 2017 to 2024, she worked as an assistant professor at the Academy of Fine Arts and Design in Bratislava, where she ran professional English seminars focused on fine arts, architecture, and design. She also supervised teaching training for students of supplementary pedagogical programme. Additionally, she worked as a consultant and reviewer of theses on didactics.

As part of her teaching activities, she participated in several Erasmus staff mobility programs, where she also ran English language seminars. In the academic year 2024–2025, she worked as an educator of professional development for English and Art Education at the National Institute for Education and Youth, where she conducted innovative trainings for elementary school teachers.

Her teaching focuses on developing presentation skills, metacognitive skills, and character, emphasizing a communicative approach.
