The aim of the conference is the meeting and discussion of domestic and foreign experts on mentioned topics, the development of cooperation in research, development, production and education.

The language of the conference is Slovak/Czech and English, with the simultaneous translation into English and Slovak.

Instruction for the autors

The speakers should represent their results in a compact form with the duration of the lecture up to 20 minutes. The short comment speakers should present their contributions up to 10 minutes. Those who wish to contribute with a poster should prepare it with the size 95×120 cm. **Short abstract** (2 – 5 sentences) **should be sent until January 5th**, **2020**. Confirmation of paper acceptance – till January 10^{th} , 2020. **The full-text paper contribution should be sent until January 31st**, **2020**, from 4 to 6 pages A5 format. All contributions and posters presented at the conference will be included in the peer-reviewed ISBN conference proceedings.
